New low maintenance gardens include:

- Easy-care permeable hardscape like pavers, gravel, pebbles
- Food, flowers, shrubs and trees in variety, but not in excess
- Native plants to attract, feed, and shelter a variety of creatures
- Compost bins, water catchment, drought-tolerant plants
