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2007 Stats on Cosmetic Surgery- ASAPS

- 11.5 million surgical & non-surgical cosmetic procedures
- 83% non-surgical/17% surgical
- Since 1997, 446% increase in number of cosmetic procedures
- Non-surgical procedures increased by >700%
- Women had 91% of cosmetic procedures, age 35-55



2007 Top 5 Cosmetic Procedures

- Botox- 2.8 million
- Hyaluronic acid fillers -1.4 million
- Laser hair removal-1.4 million
- Microdermabrasion
- Laser skin resurfacing



2007 Top 5 Surgical Cosmetic Procedures

- Breast Augmentation
- Liposuction
- Abdominoplasty
- Eyelid surgery
- Breast reduction

- Intrinsic aging
- Extrinsic aging



Intrinsic Aging

Several theories but common to them all:

- Free radicals interact with cells at the molecular level causing damage to skin and other organs
- Antioxidants quench or neutralize free radicals
- As we age, we lose the ability to completely eliminate free radicals



Extrinsic aging

- Sun exposure
- Air pollution or other environmental toxins
- Poor nutrition lacking in antioxidants
- Stress
- Excess alcohol, smoking



Extrinsic Aging: Photo-aging

- Sun damage through excessive exposure to UVA & UVB
- Increased generation of free radicals cumulative
- Daily use of photo protection SPF 30!!!



Type I. Mild (ages: 20s to 30s)

- No keratoses
- Little to no discoloration or wrinkling
- Minimal or no makeup needed



Type II. Moderate (ages: 30s to 40s)

- Early actinic keratoses
- Slight yellowish discoloration or brownish cast with increasing freckling
- Early wrinkling, especially with motion
- Light makeup usually worn (to cover skin color irregularities



Type III. Advanced (ages: 50s)

- Visible actinic keratoses
- Sallow, yellowish skin discoloration with telangiectases
- Visible wrinkles all the time
- Heavier makeup always worn to even skin color, but can accentuate deeper wrinkles



Type IV. Severe (ages: 60s to 70s)

- Actinic keratoses and skin cancers
- Almost no pink color at all
- Heavy wrinkling •Makeup cakes and cracks, not usable



New Research

Canadian women feel on average 14 years younger on the inside

They think they look on average 3 years older on the outside

Almost three quarters of Canadian women hold negative feelings about their wrinkles

Conclusions

Pigment concentration and distribution has a major influence on the perception of female facial <u>age</u>, <u>attractiveness</u>, and <u>health</u>.

Botox Cosmetic: The Science

- Prescription drug-Allergan
- Administered only through MD
- Relaxes muscles; degree and duration dose-related
- Results wear off slowly over period of several months
- Maintenance required but often lower doses over time



Botox Cosmetic: The History

- Medically proven- >500 peer-reviewed journal articles with established medical safety record of over 10 years cosmetic use
- Increasing medical indications for noncosmetic diagnoses
- Botox is often "entry level" treatment for aging upper third of face



Identical Twin Study

- One twin injected forehead and glabellar lines with Botox
 2-3 times a year for 13 years
- Treated twin does not show wrinkles compared with untreated twin "aging naturally"

Conclusion:

Regular botox injections will PREVENT the formation of wrinkles



Botox Cosmetic-The Art

- Artful placement and dosage to ensure natural looking results Face will look less stressed, less tired and more healthful
- If treatments are stopped, lining will gradually reappear but progression of wrinkling will be stopped for the duration of time that Botox is employed



New Generation of Fillers 2008 (Restylane, Juvederm & Sculptra)

- Safe, effective, long lasting, with results 6 months plus
- Natural looking



Hyaluronic Acid (HA) is...

A naturally occurring sugar found in most tissues of the human body, such as skin and cartilage

Immediate results



Signs of the Aging Face

HA depletion results in loss of volume:

- Thinning of the skin
- Loss of fullness of the lips
- Sunken eyes with fullness and brow droop
- Flattening and descent of cheeks
- Wrinkles
- Jowls



Sculptra

- Poly -L-lactic acid
- -Stimulates dermal collagen
- -Gradual improvement- 2 to 4 sessions required
- -Lifting, recontouring, smoothing, thickening of dermis

Intense Pulsed Light

- Non-invasive, broad band light (not laser)
- 5 FF treatments q4 weeks
- Gradual, "natural" improvement
- All age ranges
- Face, neck, hands, chest



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Photodynamic Therapy

- 5-aminolevulinic acid (5-ALA) photosensitizer
- Levulan Kerastick 20% ALA
- "Photodynamic" rejuvenation
- Enhances effects of IPL actinic keratoses (precancers)/ acne "IPL Boost"



Thermage

- Cleared by HPB and FDA for non-invasive mild to moderate skin firming
- Single treatment, no recovery time, "color blind", safe for skin of color or those with tan



Thermage- How does it work?

- Novel delivery of radiofrequency energy creates a heating effect in mid and deep layers of skin
- Temperature rise causes both immediate and delayed contraction of collagen fibers with neocollagenesis over several months



Thermage- Who is a Candidate?

- Not a facelift!
- Excellent adjunctive procedure for someone already using Botox and fillers
- Mild to moderate skin laxity for mild to moderate skin firming
- Age 35-50+
- Safe for all skin types



Fractionated Technologies

- Fraxel-nonablative Erbium summer 2006
- Fraxel ablative CO2 fall 2008
- Profractional ablative erbium
- Deep FX, Active FX ablative CO2
- Plasma



Plasma – New @ Skinworks

- Novel technology utilizing Nitrogen Gas; PSR technology
- Excellent for tightening eye area
- Reduction of wrinkles 40-70%
- Reduction of acne scare 35%
- Skin tightening 10-15%



Fraxel Nonablative Erbium

- Gold standard for acne scarring
- Melasma
- White scars
- Stretch marks
- Facial rejuvenation-pore reduction, sun damage
- BUT not a lot of tightening or wrinkle reduction



Fraxel Nonablative Erbium

- "Pixellated" laser wounds separated by untreated skin
- Faster healing by surrounding untreated skin
- Skin appears reddened/sun burnt for a few days, no oozing
- Followed by "bronzed" and flaking skin corresponding with extrusion of microthermal zones (MTZ) for a week



The Power of Combination Therapy

- No one technology or procedure addresses all aging concerns
- Visual impact of several carefully selected treatments is more powerful than single therapies
- Incorporate patient's desires, lifestyle, and budget
- More harmonious and natural appearing



The Power of Combination Therapy

- Maintenance treatments in conjunction with well selected skincare as adjunct
- Continued relationship with Dermatologist to oversee long term treatment plans as skin matures
- 50% of Skinworks' patients do combination treatments (defined as more than one kind of non surgical treatment)

*all patients were of more than one year duration
