



## **SATURDAY ARRIVAL BY AIR**

Which shuttle would you like to take from the San Diego Airport to The Ranch?

**Our shuttles depart San Diego Airport for The Ranch at:**

- **8:00 a.m.**
- **10:00 a.m.**
- **12:15 p.m.**

*Shuttles depart promptly at the time noted and cannot be held for those who arrive late.*

You can find our representative inside of The San Diego International Airport in both terminals:

- Terminal 1 – to the right of the escalators near baggage claim #4, right in front of Pacifica Breeze Café.
- Terminal 2 – Next to the Currency Exchange Booth, in front of baggage claim #3?

*Our staff cannot seek you out in the terminal, and we do not pick up luggage from baggage claim carousels. Travel time to The Ranch is approximately 1 hour 30 minutes.*

### **Migratory Form**

Purchase and print your tourist visa (Forma Migratoria Múltiple, or FMM) and payment receipt prior to arrival. Visit <https://www.inm.gob.mx/fmme/publico/en/solicitud.html> to obtain your visa.

**You must print the payment receipt immediately, followed by the FMM form. The form is invalid if not accompanied with the payment receipt.**

## **SATURDAY DEPARTURES TO SAN DIEGO AIRPORT**

### **Departures**

Arrangements for return transportation to the airport can be made in advance.

#### **Our shuttles depart The Ranch at:**

- **5:30 a.m.**
- **7:45 a.m.**
- **10:00am**
- **12:15 p.m.**

The Ranch staff will include the appropriate color-coded luggage tags for departure in your check-out packet. These tags will help identify which terminal your luggage will be delivered to.

Allow 3 hours travel time to get from The Ranch to the San Diego Airport and leave additional time to check-in to your flight. Actual driving times from The Ranch back to the airport are only about 1.5 hours, but we must allow an additional 1.5 hours for U.S. Customs at the border.

**Return flights should not be scheduled before 9:30 a.m.**
